LCLAA RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE MARCH 21ST MARCH IN WASHINGTON, DC FOR IMMIGRATION REFORM

As adopted by LCLAA's Executive Board on March 2nd, 2010 at 2:54 PM

Whereas, The Labor Council for Latin American Advancement (LCLAA) has gone on record calling for immediate consideration and passage of comprehensive immigration reform;

And, Whereas, LCLAA has also gone on record calling for an immediate moratorium on raids, deportations and separation of families until comprehensive immigration reform is passed;

And, Whereas, the actual number of arrests and consequent separation of families including many U.S. citizens has increased;

And, Whereas, no real efforts from the administration were made in the first year to move immigration reform forward;

And, Whereas a national march on Washington has been called for March 21st which represents a de facto deadline for the consideration of comprehensive immigration reform for Congress and the administration;

Therefore, Be It Resolved, that LCLAA endorses the March 21st March on Washington.

Be it further resolved that LCLAA will make every effort to bring people from all over the nation to Washington to make clear our commitment to an immediate moratorium on raids, deportations and separation of families and to the immediate passage of comprehensive immigration reform.
